2. Mid shots of actions.
3. Close ups of key actions/items

You may wish to include any of the following shots:

7. Canted (tilted or tilting) shots
8. ECU (extreme close up) shots
9. Tracking shots

In small groups plan the following:

Scenario

Someone is reading some documents. They turn over pages. They concentrate on a particular page. They take out a pen and make some notes on the documents. They then take out a phone, type in a number, place it to their ear and wait for it to connect.

2. Mid shots of actions.
3. Close ups of key actions/items

Scenario

Three people are sat around a table playing a game (cards, etc.). The game is clearly tense. The players look from the game to each other's faces. One is smiling, one shows no emotion, one is nervous. They take it in turns to make their moves. The tension increases. One of them wins. They all react.

You must include the following shots:

1. Establishing shot of the game

3. Close ups of key actions/items
